

Westlink M7 now open in Sydney



Australia's biggest urban road project, the Westlink M7 Motorway, is now open in Sydney.

The \$1.5 billion dollar dual carriage way road project has been successfully completed some 7 months early by the primary contractor, ABIGroup – Leighton joint venture.

The project involved some 170 bridges, 17 interchanges, 40 kilometers of roadway and upgrades / improvements to many local roads.

Transtank equipment formed an important part of the earthworks and civil construction phases of the project.



The mobile Transtank fuel farms were moved along the 40 kilometre project route as the earthmoving equipment progressed along the project site.

Equipped with the Compac Fuel Management System and Tank Gauging package, Shell were able to remotely manage the stock holdings and provide detailed regular reports to the project management team at the ABI – Leighton Joint Venture of the fuel consumption of the project.

Transtank were part of a fuel supply solution developed by the Shell Company of Australia, called Shell on Site. Shell successfully combined a complete fuel equipment and service solution encompassing Transtank Self Bunded Bulk Diesel Fuel Storage facilities, Mini Tankers on site refueling / data management services and Shell's own bulk supply and overall project management capabilities.

Transtank equipment included 6 x 68 000litre self bundled diesel fuel storage modules, Self Bunded Packaged Lubricants Stores and Transtank Spill Containment Units
